Reading Partners collaborates with schools and communities to provide comprehensive literacy support to young students, including:

- ★ two evidence-based tutoring sessions per week rooted in the science of reading and social-emotional learning.
- ★ ongoing assessments that help guide individualized, data-informed instruction for students.
- ★ representative books at the appropriate reading level to help students build personal libraries.
- ★ a suite of literacy-focused family engagement resources to support at-home learning.

329 students received 12+ sessions of one-on-one tutoring

and 360 students received one or more sessions

30 sessions per student on average

10 reading centers

459 community tutors

9,852 tutoring sessions delivered

32% of sessions delivered online via Reading Partners Connects

7,413 books distributed to students through "Take Reading with You"

36% of students are multi-language learners*
